The joint motion to consolidate Nos. 08-17378 and 08-17380 is granted.

International Union, United Automobile, and Aerospace and Agricultural

No. 08-17378, 08-17380

Implement Workers of America's motion to file an amicus curiae brief, and any responses thereto, shall be referred to the merits panel for resolution. Any further motions to file friend of the court briefs shall be treated in the same fashion.

International Union, United Automobile, and Aerospace and Agricultural Implement Workers of America shall supply the court with 10 copies of the proposed amicus brief within 7 days after the date of this order.

Appellees' opposed motion to stay appellate proceedings is granted.

Appellate proceedings are stayed until July 13, 2009.

The appellants' unopposed motion to file an oversized opening brief in No. 08-17378 is granted. The oversized opening brief received on February 9, 2009 in No. 08-17378 shall be filed.

Appellant Association of International Automobile Manufacturers's motion to file an oversized opening brief in No. 08-17380 is granted. The oversized opening brief submitted on February 12, 2009 in No. 08-17380 by appellant Association of International Automobile Manufacturers shall be filed. Association of International Automobile Manufacturers is not an appellant in case No. 08-17378, therefore, the February 9, 2009 motion to file an oversized opening brief and the oversized opening brief received February 9, 2009 shall be stricken.

The answering briefs are due July 27, 2009. The optional reply briefs are due within 14 days after the service of the last served answering brief.
